



**Renewable Energy (Colza)**  
4 days from Frankfurt to Munich

**Day 1 Frankfurt - Würzburg**

Arrival at Frankfurt airport and meet with your tour guide. Travel on via the baroque city of Fulda to the former East German border. Visit a joint venture of three village farmers producing nature oil, sharing an oil squeezer. Travel on to Würzburg in the famous wine region Franken. The lively university and congress city of Würzburg, gateway to the Romantic Road, is dominated by its most prominent landmark, the Fortress Marienberg, the origins date back to around 1000 B.C. City sight seeing of Würzburg. Dinner and overnight.

**Day 2 Würzburg - Straubing**

After breakfast depart from the hotel to Ochsenfurt. Visit a Biodiesel factory, where colza oil will be transformed to Biodiesel. Continue to Allersberg with lunch en-route. Visit a leading company for transformation tractors and engines to use colza oil and discuss with a manager. Travel on to Straubing in lower Bavaria, a charming small city with magnificent churches and outstanding historic monuments. Dinner and overnight.

**Day 3 Straubing - Munich**

Depart from hotel to the Bavarian technology and development programs center, an organization of the Bavarian government, where a specialist (called 'Colza oil pope' in Germany) will explain their work on the technology of nature raw materials. Continue towards Munich. On the way you'll visit a colza farm with own oil press, producing for own use at their engines and tractors. Travel on to Munich. Farewell dinner and overnight.

**Day 4 Munich - departure**

After breakfast start guided city sight seeing tour of Munich. Munich is a cosmopolitan city, the Bavarian capital and a place full of history. Transfer to the airport for departure.

**Forestry**  
4 days from / to Stuttgart

**Day 1 Stuttgart – Black Forest**

Arrival at Stuttgart airport and meet with your tour guide. Travel south to the Black Forest region. In Gengenbach visit the Forestry School, an vocational forestry education centre. Then have a guided tour with a local forestry manager through the reafforestation areas. Travel on to Durbach, a pretty town in the Black Forest also known for its fine wineries. Dinner and overnight.

**Day 2 Durbach / Freiburg**

After breakfast drive to Freiburg to visit the Forest Research Institute Baden-Württemberg. The FVA administrates practical research and development for the Forest Service and forest enterprises. Many projects are thus carried out in close cooperation with the other Forest Research Institutes in Germany or neighbouring countries (e.g. Austria or Switzerland). Later visit the experimental trial of the FVA in Hinterzarten. Return towards Durbach. En-route visit to a forestry machinery plant. Back in Durbach enjoy a wine tasting at a local winery. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

**Day 3 Durbach - Stuttgart**

Depart from hotel. Drive to Herrenberg to visit the forestry bureau. Together with a local representative visit to the local forestry and timber workers. Later on visit to a private forest nearby for a tour through the estate. Around 40% of the German forests are privately owned. Travel on to Stuttgart. Guided sight seeing tour of Stuttgart. The exciting metropolis has the power to charm people with its beautiful squares, palaces and buildings, in all sorts of architectural styles, not to mention its cultural diversity. Farewell dinner and overnight.

**Day 4 Stuttgart - departure**

Free time in Stuttgart until transfer to the airport for departure.
